"Indeed, much of the church has regularly believed that the grace of the whole affair is, if anything, enhanced by the normal recipients of baptism—little children. Over the years the gospel with its central message of faith will be spoken also to these children as they grow up, urgently inviting them to continue to believe what they have been given—given in the passion for them in AD 30 and applied to them in their own personal AD of baptism. Where faith is not sustained in the hearts of baptized children, the gifts really given by God in baptism are left unused in an unopened section of the human heart. The gifts can even be rejected... And then there is only judgement. ... But when the grace given in baptism is maintained and confirmed, when baptized persons turn to Christ in fresh decisions of faith, they find that Christ has always turned earlier to them, as early as their baptism."



- Celebrant: For in the night in which he was betrayed, Jesus took bread; and when he had given thanks, he broke it, and gave it to his disciples, saying, "Take, eat, this is my Body, which is given for you. Do this in remembrance of me." Likewise, after supper, he took the cup; and when he had given thanks, he gave it to them, saying, "Drink of this, all of you; for this is my Blood of the New Covenant, which is shed for you, and for many, for the remission of sins. Do this, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of me." Let us pray:
- People: We do not presume to come to this, Your Table, O merciful Lord, trusting in our own righteousness, but in your manifold and great mercies. We are not worthy so much as to gather up the crumbs under your Table. But you are the same Lord whose property is always to have mercy. Grant us therefore, gracious Lord, so to eat the flesh of your dear Son Jesus Christ, and to drink his blood, that our sinful bodies may be made clean by his body and our souls washed through his most precious blood that we may evermore dwell in him, and he in us.
- Celebrant: Gracious God, pour out Your Holy Spirit upon us and upon these Your gifts of bread and wine, that the bread we break and the cup we bless may be the communion of the body and blood of Christ. By Your Spirit make us one with Christ, that we may be one with all who share this feast, united in ministry in every place. As this bread is Christ's body for us, send us out to be the body of Christ in the world.

All this we ask through your Son Jesus Christ: By him, and with him, and in him, in the unity of the Holy Spirit all honor and glory is yours, Almighty Father, now and for ever.

And now, as our Savior Christ has taught us, we are bold to say:
People: Our Father, who art in heaven, Hallowed be Thy Name. Thy kingdom come, Thy will be done, on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread, and forgive us our debts as we forgive our debtors. Lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil, for Thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory forever. Amen.

BUILDING PROJECT UPDATE FROM TIM

Several weeks ago, I updated our church on where we are with our building project. I mentioned that several adult classrooms, a men's and women's bathroom, and our kitchen had all been cut from the current designs for budgetary reasons with the hope that by the end of the year we, as a church, could **raise \$500,000 to cover the cost of adding back these spaces** through which we can minister to our congregation, neighbors, and city.

We've had an exciting development in this endeavor. A church member has pledged a **matching gift up to \$250,000** towards the realization of this fundraising goal, meaning that if the rest of our congregation **pledges a total of \$250,000 towards our building project by November 30**, those funds will be matched and we will be able to add our classrooms, bathrooms, and kitchen back into our building plans. For those of you who have not yet joined in the capital campaign or for those who are excited about this matching gift challenge and would like to make an additional contribution, please consider making a pledge (to be fulfilled over the next two years) between now and November 30, taking this opportunity to make your gift go twice as far – a \$5,000 pledge would move


the church \$10,000 closer to its fundraising goal.
